

## ENGLISH

We start the half term writing Space poems linked to our topic. Our fictional reading and writing will be around the story 'How to catch a star'.

At the end of the half term we will be writing biographies and diaries about space focusing on Neil Armstrong. Children will also be working hard to learn different spelling patterns—adding suffixes er, est, ness, full and less.

## HISTORY/GEOGRAPHY/ SCIENCE

In history we are learning about Neil Armstrong and the first moon landing. We will be putting significant space events into a time line. In science we will be learning about light and electricity.

## PE

We will be learning about money, fractions and shape.
