September Coronavirus Updates

As we approach the end of another very interesting and somewhat difficult year we look forward to re-opening our school fully in September. However as you are all aware this will look different to our usual norm following months of COVID lockdown. School will re-open on Thursday the 3rd September for pupils from Year 1 to Year 6. Our new Reception pupils will join us the following week from the 7th of September. Each year group will be kept in their year group bubble with the nominated staff. Each bubble will have their own start time, break time and lunch time and will not mix with any other year group bubble children unless they are in morning and after school care clubs, which will be organised into smaller bubbles grouping children from similar year groups together. The staggered start times and entrance from the different areas will help to reduce large numbers gathering and allow for some social distancing. We appreciate this may be difficult for some of you but we must follow the strict guidance set out for us by the Department of Education and Public health to ensure that we keep all our school community safe.

Additional to the staggered start and finish times we will also have sanitising stations in every classroom as well as children's temperatures checked as they arrive into class in the morning. Throughout the day we will have two members of cleaning staff going around and cleaning classes and toilets whilst children are on breaks to ensure sanitisation. It is important to note that children who are absent will be unauthorised unless reasons given. The government will also issue fines for children not attending school.
