07/14 Matters arising from 16/7/14

87/13, Governor attendance at meetings The Clerk advised that Mr Ajeeb is no longer eligible to be a governor due to non-attendance, therefore there are two parent governor vacancies, **agreed** that a request for nominations will go out to parents before half term. Further **agreed in principle** that, when reconstitution is considered, a model with at least two parent governors will be maintained. It is understood that Rev MacLaren intends to step down to be replaced by Rev Buckley but confirmation of this is awaited from the Diocese. 85/13, Governor Training Jim McHugh has been asked to make some revisions to his report, the final version will be emailed to governors as soon as received.

09/14 Headteacher's report

Matters arising from the Headteacher's report:

School roll There are 18 more pupils than at September 2013 with two more new starters due shortly.

7.54pm Ms Jones entered the meeting

Discipline There are no behaviour issues at the moment, lunchtime staff are pleased to report that only two red slips have been issued so far. The new lunchtime clubs and the presence of SLT in the playground have certainly had a positive effect on behaviour.

SEN Four statements will convert to EHCPs (education, health and social plans) in the next three years.

Free school meals Universal FSM uptake for KS1 is 162. The figure for those eligible for FSM in FS/KS1 is low at 22 - probably due to a change in demographic locally. All parents are met with before admission and are supported with checking eligibility and filling in the forms. The government is understood to be guaranteeing Pupil Premium funding for one more year from April 2015 and will then review. Buildings The development plan includes roof repair/replacement, new staff lockers, cloakroom refurbishment for Years 5 and 3.

Dr Dow raised a concern that, although the remodelled main entrance is much more secure, parents do sometimes experience unreasonable queues and delays. Mrs Smith will review circulation and staffing arrangements in the area to see if this can be improved.

Swimming The school has come to a new agreement with St Bede's for a weekly one hour slot from November to July and has also secured some free sessions.

Staffing Governors asked if the school is fully staffed? Yes, appointments have been made to the three vacant playworker posts.

Funding The school is actively looking for new funding streams, for example a free trip to Lotherton Hall has been arranged and an application has been made to Kellogg's for Breakfast Club funding. It is hoped that Breakfast Club can be extended to all pupils which is something parents are keen for.

INSET Governors asked to see a copy of Mrs Smith's start of term 'Vision and Inspiration' presentation to staff.

Curriculum Poetry week will be held 13 -17 October, all classes will learn and present a poem at assembly. There will be a big focus on reading next half term.

11/14 School Improvement Plan

Matters arising from the School Improvement Plan:

Goal 1 - Improve quality of teaching and learning Monitoring generally takes place via SLT with TLRs carrying out book scrutinies. How is the new system of DHTs providing PPA cover going? It is working very well. How many outstanding teachers would you expect in an outstanding school? Probably around 60% -70%.

Goal 2 - Raise achievement in GPS and maths SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) training will be provided at the October training day. Pupils' vocabulary and mental maths skills are being developed, the KS2 timetable has been restructured accordingly.

Goal 3 - Pupils to engage with spirituality The SIAMS 'health check' is due to take place 24 November.

Goal 4 - Assessment for Learning Marking and feedback continue to be worked on so that they impact on future learning.

Goal 5 - Presentation of work The working wall in the hall is very successful - the children are keen to show their work with a sense of pride and purpose.

Goal 6 - Develop governors' knowledge and understanding of the effectiveness of school work Ongoing work.

Goal 7 - Continue to improve engagement with families to Improve attendance

Current attendance is 95.4%. **Is there a forum for presenting the school's future ambitions to parents?** This has recently been done via Positive Parents but we could certainly share further.

A parent governor commented that parents would appreciate more notice of events and that it would be very helpful to have lunch menus in advance
