
Minutes of the Meeting of the Governing Body of Heaton St Barnabas' CE Primary School 16 October 2018

Meeting commenced at 6.40pm with a prayer

Azeema Raja, new parent governor, was welcomed and introduced Clerk took the chair for items 1-3

01/18 **Apologies for Absence**

Apologies were received from Dr Dow and Ms Walters: (in line with Governing Body policy their apologies were not recorded as being accepted).

Mrs Raja advised she would need to leave early.

Rev Helm has retired from the Parish and therefore has resigned as a governor.

02/18 **Declarations of Interest**

No declarations of interest for the current meeting.

Declarations of pecuniary interest for 18/19 were completed by those present.

03/18 Chair and Vice Chair of Governors - confirmation of term of office and election

Chair term of office confirmed as two years. Mr Grant was nominated as Chair.

6.45pm, Mr Grant left the meeting

Ms Phillips proposed Mr Grant as Chair, 18/20, seconded Mr Howorth and unanimously approved by the Governing Body.

6.46pm, Mr Grant returned to the meeting and took the Chair

In light of Dr Dow's intended resignation from the GB it was agreed to elect a Vice Chair at this point, two nominations were received for Ms Phillips and Mr Howorth.

6.50pm, Ms Phillips and Mr Howorth left the meeting

Governors voted in favour of Ms Phillips as Vice Chair for one year, 18/19, approved.

6.51pm, Ms Phillips and Mr Howorth returned to the meeting

Two items of AOB notified.

Minutes of 17/7/18 05/18

The minutes of 17/7/18 were **agreed** as a correct record.

06/18 Matters arising from 17/7/18

Governor's Action Plan and evaluation for 17/18 and new Action Plan for 18/19 were distributed.

6.55pm Mr Ali entered the meeting

Matters arising from the new Plan:

- Mrs Mushtag will be the named governor for SIAMS (Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools)
- The Diocese is hoping to appoint a new incumbent for St Barnabas' as soon as possible.
- Agreed to include a governor's update in the newsletter each term
- Meet and greet to be arranged soon after half term
- Governors will be encouraged to attend pupil progress meetings, learning walks etc.
- Strategic 3 year overview was distributed, any queries can be raised with the Head or with staff at the meet and greet

07/18 Headteacher's report

Matters arising from the Headteacher's report and from governor's questions:

- Pupils numbers were up at the October census (now 405)
- There has been less take up for universal free school meals in KS1 and it is generally difficult to persuade eligible parents to apply for FSM despite incentives such as free uniform

- There is still little clarity regarding funding from April 2019 but it is likely to be £30k-£50k less with the teacher pay rise of between 3% and 5% only part-funded
- School is significantly above floor targets in all subjects
- The gap in reading has been narrowed significantly but there is still a disparity between girls and boys at the end of KS2
- It is hoped that the Year 1 Phonics score of 84% can be improved this year; there is a renewed emphasis on phonics throughout school including whole staff training
- It is unfortunate that progress measure score has been affected by 8 children not having KS1 scores
- Swimming lessons have been secured for both Year 3 and Year 5
- Residentials will take place at Nell Bank (Y3) and Buckden House (Y5)
- Mrs Mason has taken over Mrs Wild's safeguarding role and Mr Clark will train as a designated safeguarding lead
- Governors were impressed with the provision of online safety awareness in school
- There are now 56 SEND pupils including several with additional/complex needs.
 One wheelchair user was admitted very late the school was able to make the necessary adjustments but is generally very stretched in terms of adequate support for SEND pupils
- The new Reception intake has settled in very well
- A volunteer is needed to run the school chess club
- The library space refurbishment is complete so books and furniture can be ordered with a view to opening by the end of term
