

## ENGLISH

This half term children will be looking at traditional tales with a twist! As part of our topic we will also be learning about non-fiction texts such as leaflets and fact files on plants and animals. Our class novel this half term is 'The Faraway Tree'.

## GEOGRAPHY AND SCIENCE

In Geography the children will be learning to understand simple compass directions and recognise geographical features of the local environment. We will also be drawing maps to show Little Red Riding Hoods journey. In science children will be learning to identify and classify plants from the local area and name a variety of common animals.

## ICT

We will be learning to be safe online and communicating with others respectfully.

## PE

Children will be developing their balance, co-ordination and dance skills this half term.

## MATHS

Children will be practicing recognizing and writing numbers to 1000 and beyond. They will also be learning the place and value of these numbers and begin to sort them into odd and even. We will be revising 10 more and 10 less than a number up to 1000.

## RE

In RE we are learning about the Christian story of Creation and responding in different ways, thinking about how God would like us to look after the world.

## ART /DESIGN / MUSIC

Children will be designing and building habitats for woodland animals. They will also be sketching different animals. In music we will be composing short rhythms to represent different animals.
