For **Maths** this week, I would like you to attempt some 'new' maths from White Rose Maths. This is the maths scheme that we follow in school. It is very good because it includes lots of images when explaining new maths and because it also has reasoning and problem solving questions.

Start on Week 1 and work through at your own pace. You don't have to catch up on previous weeks – we will do this together when we are back at school. You can find the White Rose Maths at <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-5/>

On top of this, I am setting you 'revision' maths lessons that you can do on MyMaths – this week, these are on Perimeter and Area. There are also 'Problems of the Day' on the school website (in the Year 5 area) for those of you who like a deeper maths challenge and an arithmetic paper. Please remember to practise your times tables and number bonds – 10 minutes a day is plenty.

For **Reading**, please log in to ReadTheory **every day** to do **20 minutes** of the short reading comprehension tasks. After this, I would like you to read a book or magazine of your choice for 30 minutes or so. For **Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar**, I have set you four punctuation and grammar tasks, and four spelling quizzes on Purple Mash.

I also want to let you know that from Monday, 20th April, BBC Bitesize will be broadcasting daily lessons on their website, on BBC iPlayer and on the Red Button service (press the red button on your TV remote). I think these are going to be really interesting and I would encourage you to try them out this week.
