English

We have set a **spelling task each day**, revising spellings from Y4 (Monday-Wednesday via Purple Mash) and learning spellings from Y5 (Thursday-Friday) using the spellings resources which can be accessed from the school website. We have also uploaded a handwriting practice sheet.

Children should log onto the **Read Theory** website and complete a comprehension task **daily** Monday-Thursday. On **Purple Mash** there will be a reading comprehension activity on Friday linked to our topic – there will be a new chapter of this book added each week also.

On **Purple Mash** there will be a **daily** grammatical activity set for the children to complete. Oak Academy has an online lesson per day to complement these activities revising the Year 4 objectives: https://classroom.thenational.academy/units/t2-word-level-objectives-8c26

Maths

Maths work can be accessed daily via **MyMaths**. There is an online lesson per day. Additionally there are set activities per day on MyMaths to complete. Children should also be practising on **TT Rockstars** <u>daily</u> to consolidate their times tables.

Afternoon sessions:

Monday: On a Monday we do ICT and PSHE in the afternoon. Mr Clark has provided an online safety activity as well as some programming tasks via **Purple Mash**. In PSHE we have been thinking about kindness and courage. There is an activity on **Purple Mash** to complete linking to faith stories.

Tuesday: On a Tuesday we have RE and Music. We have been thinking about the story of Creation. Lots of people have responded differently to this – through music (Joseph Haydn's *The Creation* for example) and art. We would like the children to choose a way to respond to the Creation story and produce a piece of art or music linked to it. It might be their favourite section of the story or how they feel about it. Please email any completed work to us – and bring it in to school to display when we return on the 1st!

Wednesday: On a Wednesday we do science. There are a range of sorting activities linked to materials on **Purple Mash.** Oak Academy have an online lesson on the absorbency of materials https://classroom.thenational.academy/lessons/which-materials-are-absorbent-6tk3er - send any photographs of your experiments to us and we hope you enjoy taking part!

Thursday: On a Thursday we have Topic. There are a range of activities on **Purple Mash** linking to the outbreak of World War 1 to complete. BBC bitesize https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zqhyb9q/articles/znhhrj6 gives you lots of information to help you complete the tasks.

Friday: For Friday's afternoon activity we would like you to start a Learning Log task of your choice – you can bring this back into school to show us when we return on the 1st October.

We hope this work will help you to keep in routine with your learning – these are the topics we would be covering in school and are similar activities to those we would be doing in class. We can't wait to see your work on Purple Mash, TT Rockstars and MyMaths, plus also please email us any creative work or any questions.
