

Topic

In History, children will be learning about the Ancient Greeks—when and where they lived, and how they established their empire. They will learn who the Ancient Greeks were, what historical artefacts tell us about their lives, Alexander the Great and his legacy, and the lasting impact of the Ancient Greeks on our modern lives. In Geography, we will be learning about mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes.

Art/DT

Children will be researching and evaluating Ancient Greek vase designs. We will be drawing and illustrating our own Greek vases and decorating them with images from the Greek Myths we read. In DT, we will be working with wood and making a small household utensil.

RE

This half term children will be learning about how different faiths carry out pilgrimages. The children will be thinking about their own special places.

ICT

Children will be learning about using IT as part of a balanced lifestyle. They will learn about the reliability and validity of information found on the Internet.

English
