# *THE REFUGEES*

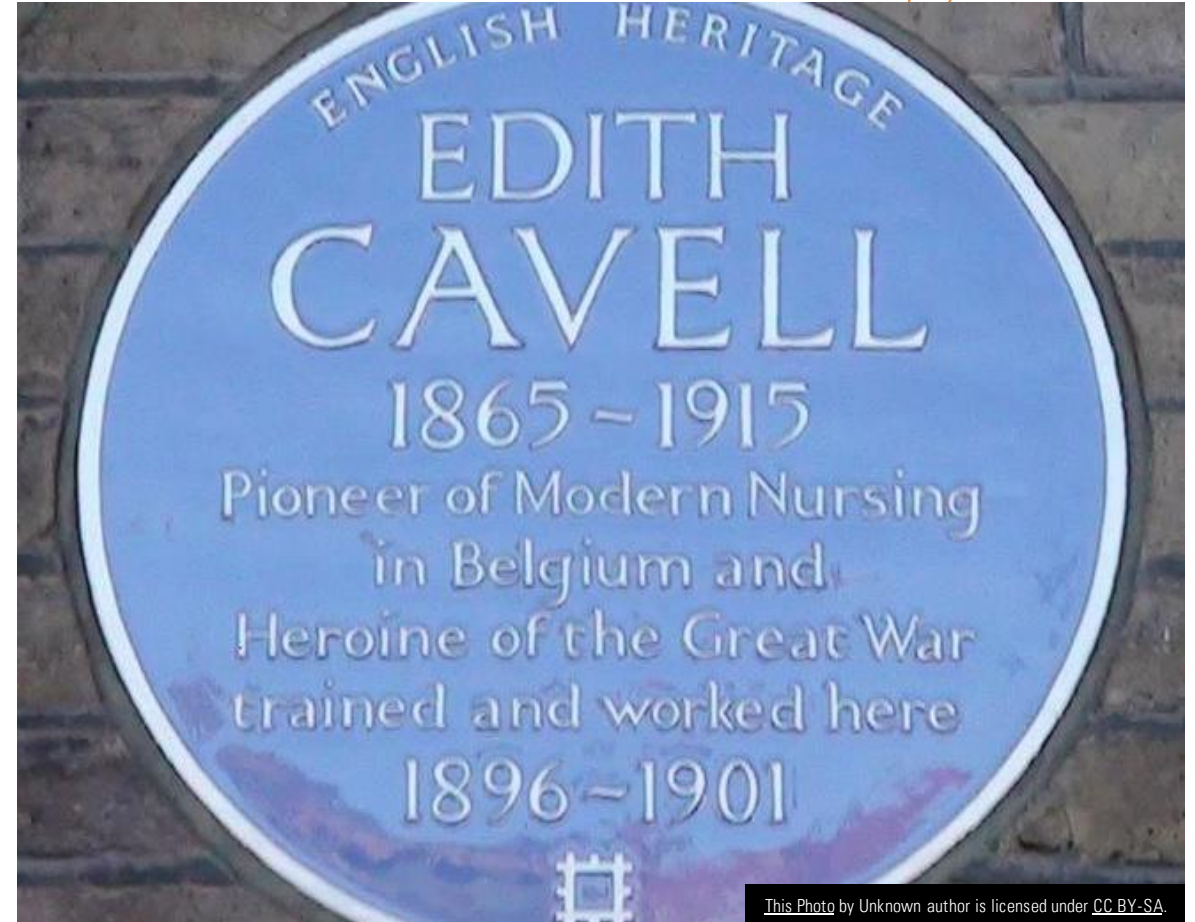

She carried on doing this .
