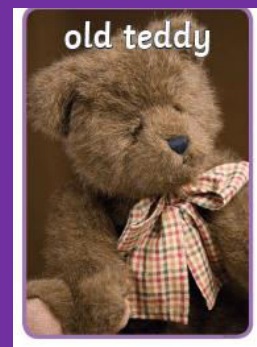
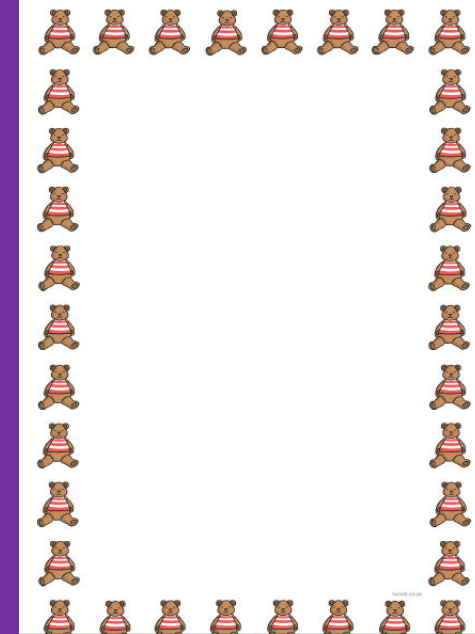
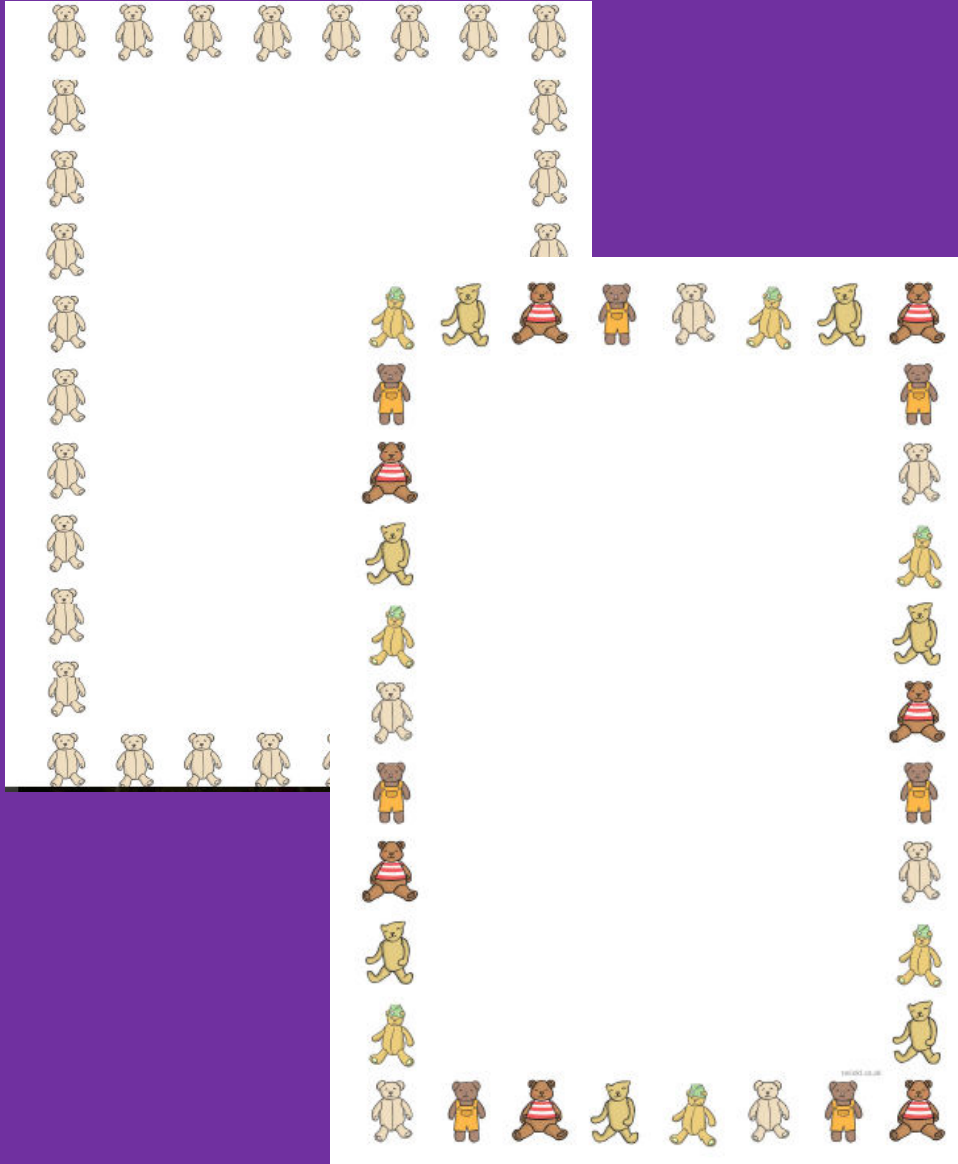
Which is old? Which is new? How can you tell?
