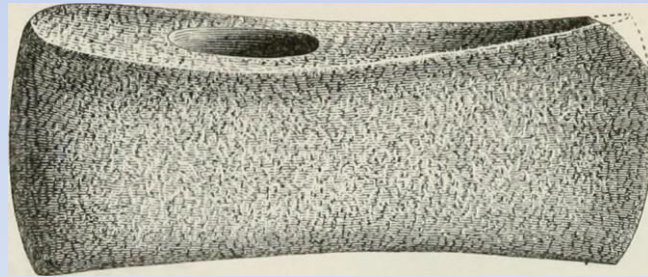


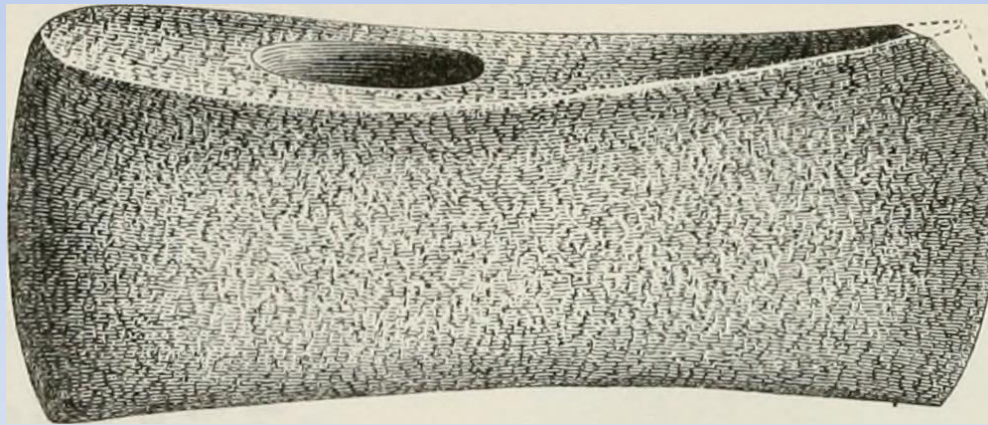
Starter Activity

head.



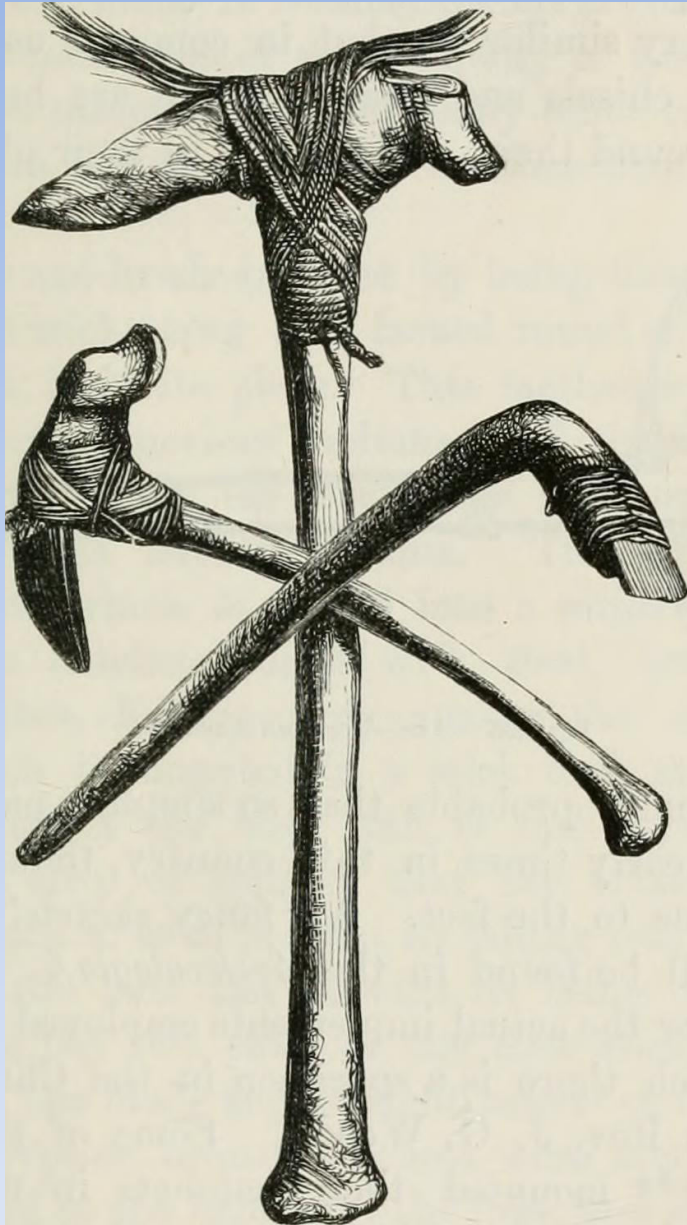
What might this have been used for?
