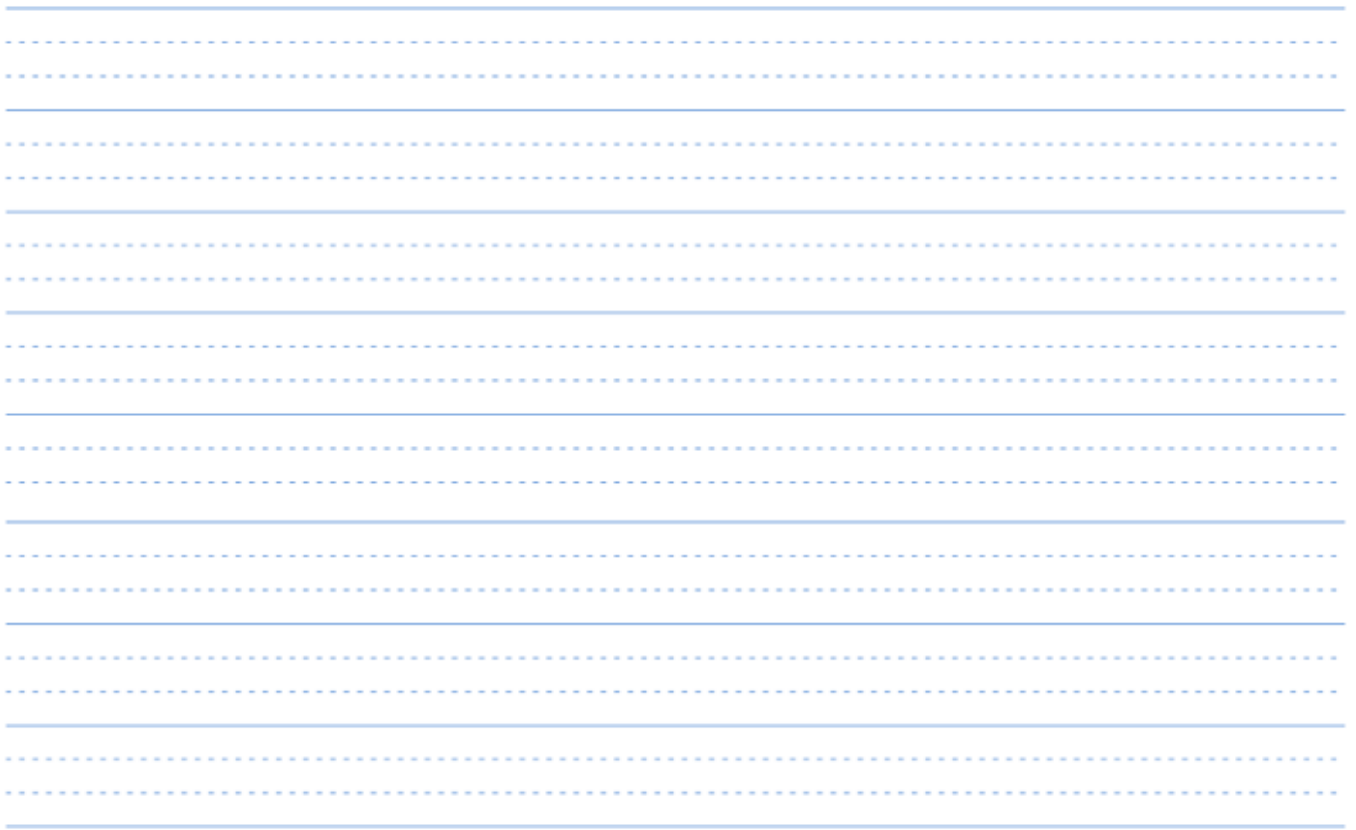

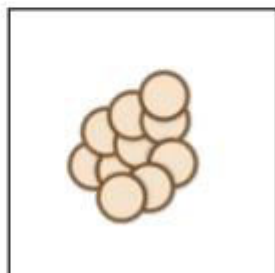
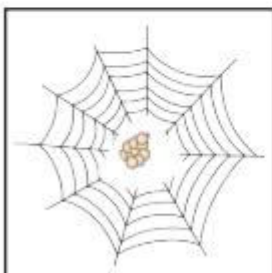
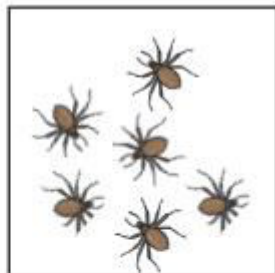
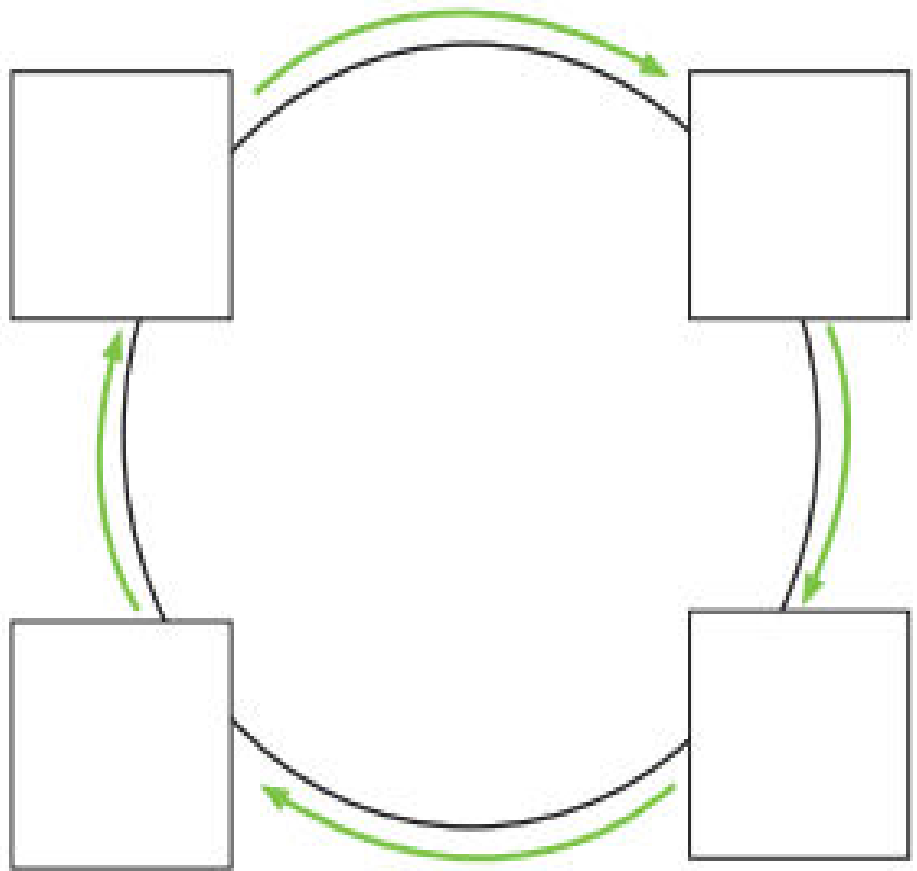
2. What do they eat?

These phonics lessons will change every 24 hours.


In year 1 the children need to learn all of the set 2 sounds and all of the set 3 sounds.






Read and Hold a Sentence 1 (from Set 3 Speed Sounds & Word Time Spelling)

5. Watch and join in with the read and hold a sentence 1 lesson, write and mark your sentence


