

# English

We will begin by learning about Scotland and a story called Robert the Bruce and the Spider. We will be focussing on sentence structure, using the word and, and ensuring that all sentences have capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Next we will visit Ireland and learn about giants. We will design and write about our own giants. We will be focussing on using a capital letter for the pronoun I along with capital letters for names of people and places.

# Maths

We will be learning about the number 11-20, finding out about place value, that 11 is 10 and 1 more. We will be comparing, ordering numbers, learning to write the numbers with correct formation and spelling them in words. We will then begin adding and subtracting numbers within 20 using tens frames, bar models, part whole models and number lines. We will also be solving practical problems involving numbers up to 20. We will also be learning how to count in 10s and 2s.

## History/Geography

We will learn about Robert the Bruce, Robert Burns and Burns night and St Patrick. We will be making maps of the UK and learning about the natural and human features of each country.

We will be making Scottish tartan by printing with paint and weaving paper. We will plan, make and evaluate an Irish stew and make some Scottish shortbread.

# Science

We will continue to follow our trees in the school grounds, noting their changes and discussing the weather. We will be finding out about the animals in Scotland and Ireland and where they live. We will also search for birds and find out which birds visit the school grounds. We will even complete a science investigation deciding which material would be the best for mending a hole in a bucket.
