

ENGLISH

This half term we will be looking at the book 'Winter's Child'. We will be using the illustrations to describe settings, we will be writing diary entries as the characters and we will also be writing our own stories set in a cold place. We will also be reading non-fiction texts about polar animals and explorers!

SCIENCE

This half term we will be looking at Materials and their uses, we will be thinking about the types of materials used by a polar explorer. We will also be looking at animals and their habitats, thinking about how animals have adapted to survive in cold places.

ICT

We will be researching facts about polar regions on the ipads and chrome books.

PSHE

We will be focusing on the theme: 'Living in the Wider World' and we will be discussing different roles/jobs and our own responsibilities as citizens.

Polar Explorers!

Geography/ History

We will be locating polar regions on a map and discussing the climate and the animals that live there. We will also be discussing global warming and what we can do to protect the polar regions. We will also be learning about famous polar explorers from the past and present.

REMOTE LEARNING

As we are currently in lockdown and learning remotely we will adapt our usual coverage to be accessible in a remote environment. Any areas of the curriculum not covered remotely will be of priority when we return to school.

MATHS

This half term we will revise place value and addition/subtraction. We will be looking at money-identifying the values of coins and notes to solve word problems involving money. We will also be looking and multiplication and division calculations.

RE

In RE we are learning about Judaism. We will take a virtual tour of a synagogue and learn about special celebrations for Jewish people.

ART /DESIGN / MUSIC

We will use watercolours to paint an arctic landscape, we will design our own eco-bags to reduce the use of plastic. We will design and make our own flags to put on the North Pole!
