

Topic

In Topic we will be finding out about the county of Yorkshire. We will be looking at where the Yorkshire Dales National Park is and why people visit it. We will also be working on our geographical skills including compass points and grid references.

Ain't Yorkshire Sweet

English

In English we will be looking at a poem written by a Yorkshire poet and will be completing descriptive writing about the places you can visit in Yorkshire. In Reading, we will be completing our class reader *The Boy at the Back of the Class* and looking at a range of texts in Guided Reading.

Art and DT

In DT, we will be using different sewing techniques to make a Yorkshire landscape.

In Art, we will be looking at Yorkshire artists including the work of David Hockney and sculptures by Henry Moore.

Science

In Science, we will be studying the topic of Living Things and their Habitats. We will be linking this to our Ain't Yorkshire Sweet topic through focusing on animals and plants from the local area.

Maths

This half term, we will be learning how to do short and long multiplication before moving on to learning short division. We will then begin an extended unit on fractions— finding equivalent fractions and adding, subtracting and multiplying mixed numbers and improper fractions.

REMOTE LEARNING

As we are currently in lockdown and learning remotely we will adapt our usual coverage to be accessible in a remote environment. Any areas of the curriculum not covered remotely will be of priority when we return to school.

RE

This half term we will be asking questions about, and finding out why, some people believe in God and others do not.
