***Cider with Rosie*, by Laurie Lee**

Read the extract from *Cider with Rosie* by Laurie Lee on p.10 of the CGP Y6 Comprehension Targeted Question Book and answer these questions.

- 1) How do we know that this day is a hot day?
- 2) Look at the description of the grass in the second paragraph. How is the grass made to seem threatening? Explain, referring to the text to support your answer.
- 3) What impression do we get of the sun from the second and the fourth paragraphs? Explain, using references to the text to help explain your answer.
- 4) What had the author's sisters been doing before they came to meet him? How do you know?
- 5) What impressions do you get of the author's relationship with his sisters? Explain, referring to the text to support your answer.
- 6) The extract describes the author's impression of coming to the village of Slad for the first time at the age of 3. Based on the experiences he recounts, what inferences can you make about the author's life before this? Explain why you think this.
