

# English

This half term will begin by focusing on the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk', and learning about sentence structure and punctuation. We will be practising putting sentences together in different ways, and begin to learn about how to use conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions. We will then learn the fun story 'The Queen's Knickers' and sequence our own sentences to form short narratives about London.

# Maths

We will be learning about the numbers 20 to 50. We will be investigating how the numbers are made using tens and ones. We will focus on representing numbers eg. 36 is made up of 3 tens and 6 ones. We will then use this knowledge to help us to compare numbers (e.g. 36 is smaller than 46 because 36 has 3 tens and 46 has 4 tens). This knowledge will help us to put numbers to 50 in order.

# History/Geography

We will learn about human and physical features of Northern Ireland and London. Will find out about St Patrick and St George. We will find out about the Giant's Causeway and the Great Fire of London.

# Art/DT

We will make 3d models of London landmarks and make some moving pictures using sliders and turning parts. We will practise drawing and painting skills.

# Science

This half term we will learn all about plants. We will identify, classify and sort plants and think about which plants grow in Britain, before doing some research on what plants need to be able to grow. We will complete investigations, which will focus on pattern seeking, for example 'Do all flowers have the same amount of petals?' and 'Do all apples have the same number of seeds?' and talk about our results, drawing conclusions.
