

## ENGLISH

The children will read *The Pebble in my Pocket* and explore new vocabulary to understand the meaning of a text and use their senses to describe different settings. We will also be writing a set of detailed instructions on how to create your own volcano.

## SCIENCE/DT

In Science, the theme of plant life-cycles will be covered across the year so that the children can understand how plants change in different seasons. We will think about animals (including humans), including why we have skeletons and muscles and why nutrition is important.

## ICT

We will create pictograms and bar charts using ICT. We will also use Purple Mash to try to create a time line.

## PE

We will be learning about the game of rugby.

## PSHE

We will be using the idea of the pebble to think about how they are all different and all very special.

We will also focus on why should we eat well and look after our teeth; why should we keep active and sleep well.

## MATHS

In our second half term, we will be looking at pictograms and bar charts; length and perimeter. We will be concentrating on mm, cm and m and using these measures (and equivalences) to calculate the perimeter of shapes.

## DT/ART/MUSIC

We will be creating our own 2D and 3D volcanoes. We will use the description from the story to help us.
