1. migrate

Definition: to move from one place to another.

Same word family:
Immigrate: to move to another country to live there.

In the winter, some birds migrate to a warmer place.

The Celts migrated across Europe.

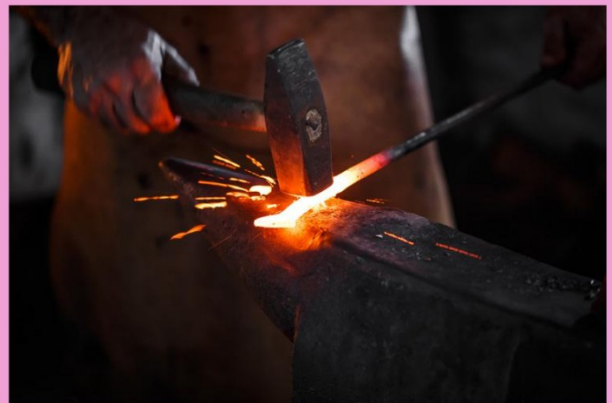
1. migrate

2. forge

Definition: to make or shape a metal object by heating and hammering it.

The Celts would forge weapons out of iron.

We will forge ahead with our plans.

Eg. Many different metals can be forged to make weapons.

3. raid

Definition: a rapid surprise attack, especially to take something.

The Celts were known to raid each other's settlements.

The police raided a house the other day.

Eg. The Celts would raid other villages for food and weapons.

4. common

Definitions:

- 1) easily found.
- 2) shared with others.

Antonyms: **rare, special**

Definition: The gift of something to a god as an act of worship.

Evidence of animal sacrifice during the Iron Age has been found.

Parents make big sacrifices for their children; especially giving up sleep.
