Magnetic letters and numbers....can children pair them up and write them down?



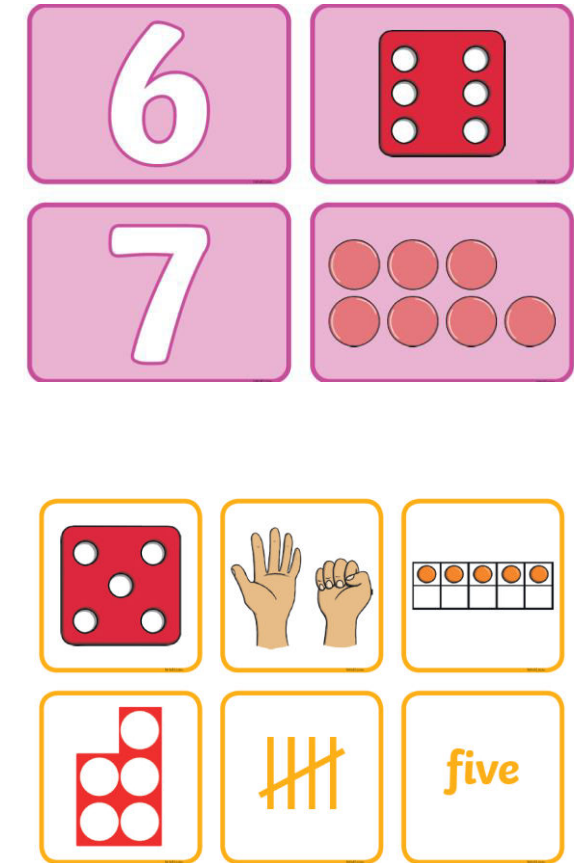
Funky fingers:

Pair up the number representations



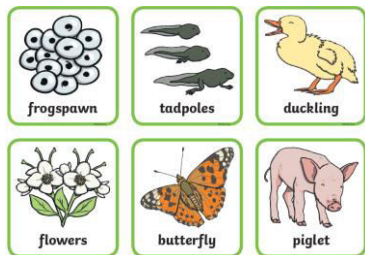

- Spring pairs! Spring objects/items to match up



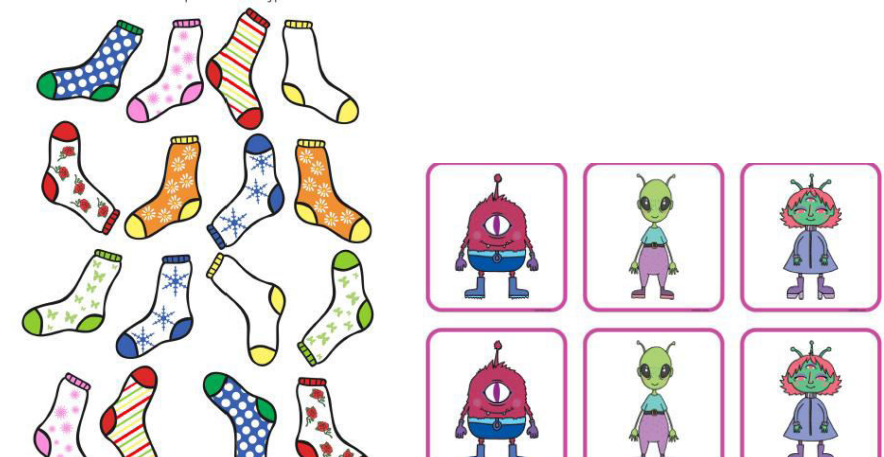
- ICT – polar bears pair game on IWB
