Stained-Glass Window Craft

You will need:

- Window Template
- Cross Template
- Black sugar paper or card
- Brightly coloured tissue paper
- PVA glue
- Glue spreaders
- Scissors
- Pencil



Instructions

- 1. Cut out the Window Template and the Cross Template.
- 2. Place the cut-outs onto black sugar paper or card and draw around them. Carefully, cut them out.
- 3. Tear the coloured tissue paper into small pieces.
- 4. Next, spread a small amount of glue around the window frame. Make sure you don't use too much glue this will cause the tissue to bunch up or tear.
- 5. Start to layer the tissue paper so that it slightly overlaps. Stick each piece in place with a little bit of glue.
- 6. Keep repeating this last step until the whole of the window frame is covered. Make sure there are no gaps between the pieces of tissue paper!
- 7. Add some glue onto one side of the cross. Stick the cross in the middle of your window. Make sure you stick it on the correct side and not the side where the tissue paper overlaps the window frame.
- 8. Leave it to dry completely.
- 9. Stick or hang your stained-glass window where lots of light can shine through and show the beautiful colours!
