

Science

We will be studying the planets and the solar system. We will answer the questions like: 'How big are the Earth, Sun and Moon in comparison to Pluto?', 'Why are the seasons different?' and 'Why does it get dark earlier in the winter?'.

Art

We will use different sewing techniques, including running stitch and cross stitch, to complete a class banner relating to space.

Maths

In maths we will be continuing to learn about fractions, decimals and percentages. As we move further into the term we will be spiralling back to multiplication and division this time with a focus on the year 5 curriculum. We will build into our teaching and classroom activities a focus on the topics of space, shape, measure and statistics to refresh this learning whilst maths lessons will maintain a focus on number .
