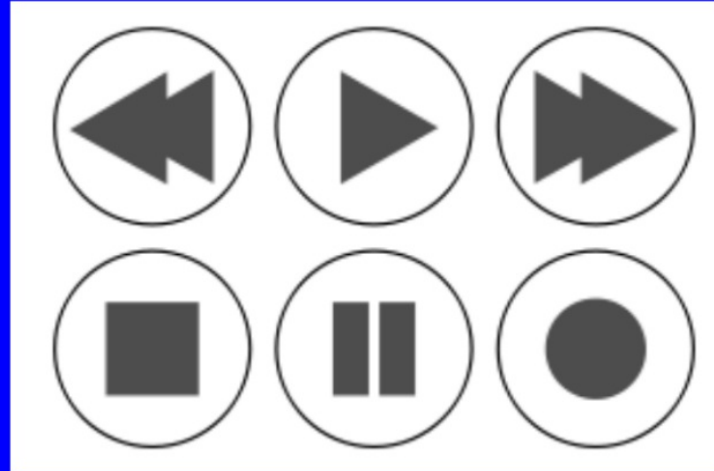


You are in control.
