Mid-Day Meals

We now operate a cafeteria-system for school lunches, which allows an element of choice for your son/daughter if they choose to have a cooked meal. Alternatively, they may prefer to bring a packed lunch.

The class teachers will take a dinner register every morning; therefore, your child is able to change their meal preference on a daily basis.

All meals are eaten in the school dining-hall under the supervision of our team of lunchtime supervisors.

Halal meals are served on **Monday**, **Tuesday**, **Wednesdays and Thursdays** for Muslim children. Fish is served every Friday. Children from other faiths are also able to eat halal with parent's permission.

Vegetarian meals are available every lunchtime.

If your child has any food allergies, please arrange via the school office to meet with the Catering Manager.

Meals currently cost £1.90 per day or £9.50 per week for Years 3, 4, 5 and 6.

Please note Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive Universal Infant Free School Meals.

Dinner money must be paid online via ParentPay system. www.parentpay.co.uk You will receive an activation letter for this during your child's first week with us.

Where a packed lunch is brought it must be:

In a self-sealing container, or bag clearly marked with your child's name and class.

Please ensure your child's packed lunch does not contain any nuts, nut products and

Please ensure your child's packed lunch does not contain any nuts, nut products a sesame seeds - this is due to pupils' allergies.

The success of our lunchtime system depends largely on the children's behaviour and attitude. Naturally, lunchtime is the time for relaxation. Anti-social behaviour <u>is not</u> tolerated in the interests of safety, as well as the welfare of children and staff. If children are persistently disobedient, it will be necessary for me to inform you and request that they are taken home for the lunch hour.
