
#### Who Were the Ancient Greeks?

Greece was one of the most important places in the ancient 11 world – there is evidence of settlers from around 40,000BC, 20 but the influential period was around 2,500BC onwards. 28 These ancient Greeks were fantastic thinkers, writers, actors, 36 artists, athletes, warriors, architects and politicians. 42

The Greeks called themselves 'Hellenes' and their land was 51 'Hellas'. The name 'Greeks' was given to the people of Greece 62 later by the Romans. They lived in mainland Greece (which 72 was split into city-states including: Athens, Sparta, Corinth 80 and Olympia) and the Greek islands, but also in colonies 90 scattered around the Mediterranean Sea, including: Italy, 97 Sicily, Turkey, North Africa, and even France. 104


