

Geography This term we will be asking: 'What is beyond Bradford?' We will identify and locate parts of Yorkshire on a variety of maps, focusing on Yorkshire towns and cities, describing their locations in geography terms, and discussing their human and physical features. We will make a Big Book all about Yorkshire (and the UK) and teach all the things we learn to a different year group in our Yorkshire experience day!

Art & DT Throughout this term we will use sketchbooks to develop our understanding of line, drawing from observation, and building our understanding of colour and texture through paint and printmaking. We will learn to join materials through sewing a bag, using different threads. We will be prepare and cook curry, Yorkshire pudding and Yorkshire parkin. Yum!

RE This half term we will learn about God as a creator; discuss the Bible story of creation and question whether faith and science can ever fit together. In addition, we will be responding to the idea that we all have a responsibility to look after God's creation - the Earth.

Computing We will learn about e-safety and all about search engines—what they are and how to use them. We will then create and edit a slideshow about Yorkshire, using information researched and gathered, and images of the Yorkshire landscape.

PHSE Children will be learning about families and relationships.

Spanish We will be revising phonetics and pronunciation. We will also be learning to talk about our homes and where we live.

English This half term we will be learning how to write poetry. We will be looking closely at how we write by 'noticing' the things around us, and paying close attention. Our poetry will focus on the landscape around us, how it looks, smells, feels. We will then move on to a wonderful setting description, using all the skills from our poetry and building on them, whilst gathering new vocabulary and learning new grammar and ways to use punctuation. Exciting!

Science Our amazing science investigations will look at materials in great depth! We will investigate the properties of various materials in terms of their transparency, solubility, conductivity (electrical and thermal), response to magnets, and learn how to describe how to recover a substance from a solution. Wow!

Maths We will be comparing, ordering and rounding numbers, and using these skills to think about and solve maths reasoning problems. We will then learn about negative numbers, and how to use them.

PE This half term we will be learning gymnastics skills; creating sequences, developing a routine, partner work, and performance.

Music We will be using 'Charanga' to learn songs about Yorkshire. We will listen and recall simple musical patterns, and sing in unison, as part of a group performance!
