- We will also visit the library on **Wednesday**.

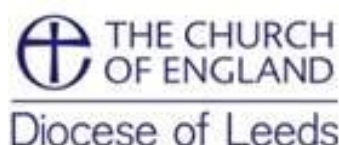
**Please ensure that all items are clearly labelled with your child's name.**
