Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back and Happy New Year. I hope you have had a restful New Year, and that the children are ready to learn. We now have a new topic, *Blooming Brilliant Britain*. In this topic, we will be learning about the four countries of the UK, starting with Scotland and Wales. We will have **two dressing up days** this half term – a **Scottish dressing up day on Friday 26th January**, where you can wear Scottish clothes or the colours of the Scottish flag (blue and white) or purple for the Scottish flower, the thistle; and a **Welsh dress up day on Thursday 8th February**, where we will wear either yellow for the daffodil, the flower of Wales, or red for the flag.

Please complete the homework in the light pink book given at the beginning of the year. There are lots of lovely activities linked to our topic that will help children's learning. Please return this by **Friday, 2nd February**. On this day, all the children will share their homework.

To make learning fun and meaningful over the coming term, we have arranged lots of experiences that the children will really enjoy, including a trip to the park and a trip to **Bolling Hall Museum on 9th February 2023**.

Each week, children bring home their two reading books. Please read these books at home every day and sign the reading record each time your child reads.

Here are a few reminders of the days, dates and times that are important this term.

- The door to Year 1 opens at 8.35am and closes at 8.45am. The register is taken at 9.00 am. Please ensure that children are in school on time as children who are late miss important learning.
