

English

This half term will begin by focusing on the story of 'Naughty Bus' by Jan and Jerry Oke.

We will be focusing on using our sets 2 and 3 phonics to help us to spell. We will be writing diary entries, letters and information booklets all about buses. We will practise adding suffixes 'ing', 'ed' 'es' and 's' to root words.

Maths

We will be learning about the numbers 20 to 50. We will be investigating how the numbers are made using tens and ones. We will focus on representing numbers eg. 36 is made up of 3 tens and 6 ones. We will then use this knowledge to help us to compare numbers (e.g. 36 is smaller than 46 because 36 has 3 tens and 46 has 4 tens). This knowledge will help us to put numbers to 50 in order.

History/Geography

We will learn about human and physical features of the UK and our local area. We will also be looking at seasonal changes and weather.

This half term we will be focusing on seasonal changes as we move from Winter into Spring.

We will be keeping a daily weather chart to notice temperature changes.
