

## ENGLISH

In English we will be continuing writing descriptions. The children are enjoying writing setting descriptions. We will then be writing instructions including instructions for cooking and baking.

Our whole class reading sessions will continue on a range of texts and focus on retrieval and inference questions.

## GEOGRAPHY / HISTORY

We will be looking at the seven wonders of the world and linking it to our studies on the stone age through to Iron Age. We will look at land use over time in Geography and the effect of erosion.
