

Wider Learning This term, we will be asking, 'What is beyond Bradford?' We will identify and locate parts of Yorkshire on maps, focus on Yorkshire towns and cities, describe locations in geography terms, and discuss human and physical features. We will make a Big Book all about Yorkshire (and the UK) and teach all the things we learn to a different year group in our Yorkshire experience day!

Art & DT We will use sketchbooks to develop our understanding of line, draw from observation, and build our understanding of colour and texture through paint and printmaking. We will learn to join materials through sewing a bag, using different threads. We will be prepare and cook curry, Yorkshire pudding and Yorkshire parkin. Yum!

RE This half term we are learning about God as a Creator. We will discuss the Bible story of creation and question how faith and science fit together.

Computing We will create and edit a slideshow about Yorkshire, using information and images of the Yorkshire landscape that we have researched and gathered. We will learn about the term 'copyright' and discuss the consequences of copying and sharing without permission.

English This half term we will consolidate our learning from Year 4 and focus on grammar, punctuation, spelling and handwriting skills. We will move on to writing a forest setting description. This will be inspired by our outdoor learning sessions in the forest. We will look closely at how we write by 'noticing' the things around us. Our setting description will focus on the landscape around us, how it looks, smells and feels. We will then move on to learning how to write poetry, using all the skills from our setting description.

Science We will investigate the properties of various materials in terms of their transparency, solubility, conductivity (electrical and thermal), response to magnets, and also learn how to describe recovering a substance from a solution.

Maths We will begin learning about place value, and comparing, ordering and rounding numbers. We will use these skills to think about and solve maths reasoning problems. We will then learn about negative numbers, and how to use them.

PE This half term we will be learning gymnastics skills—creating sequences, developing a routine, working with a partner, and performance.

Music We will be using 'Charanga' to learn songs about Yorkshire. We will listen and recall simple musical patterns, and sing in unison, as part of a group performance!
